


Why Russia is interested in Connecting Via CPEC

Geo strategic Location and Security

- Pakistan is significant for Russia in two dimensions.
- First, Security issue. As an outlet to the Central Asian Republics and the Kremlin would never desire instability there due to militant threat.
- Second, the strategic location of Pakistan connecting the Central Asian region with the Middle East and Indian Ocean — thus Russian goods can access the international market very conveniently through Pakistan


2017 Agreement worth \$8 billion in energy sector

- and development of Energy Sector.




\$2 billion North South RLNG Pipeline

\$10 billion-dollar offshore gas pipeline

- MOU is signed in September 2018 for an offshore gas pipeline from Iran to Pakistan and India.
- Similar MOUs are to be signed with India and Iran.
- Project was frozen in 2013 due to sanctions against Iran and then Russia and Iran revived it in 2017.
- Feasibility report is yet to be prepared.
